Keep toys out of view with furniture that has built-in storage. It's a nifty trick to avoid any mess.

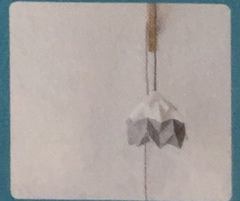
